# SPECIFICATION FOR GRASS VERGE MANAGEMENT CONTRACT 2022

Location of verges:

At the junction of London Road and the A2 slip road The area of the Canterbury-bound bus stop The area opposite Dunkirk Car Sales The area from the large road sign coming off the A2 up to the bus shelter opposite Courtenay Road, The traffic island near Remus Around the London Road sign.

### Works to be undertaken

A 1.2 metre to 1.5 metre wide grass verge to be cut monthly six times per year, commencing in June A further 1 metre wide mown path be maintained from the exit of Forrester's Lodge to the bus shelter opposite Courtenay Road

All other areas to be left for pollinator habitat and to be mown only once per annum, in the Autumn Areas to be cleared of litter and legally recycled prior to commencing works

Removal of all cuttings and their legal, green recycling disposal after works completed

No insecticides or herbicides to be used with prior written consent of the Council

All works to be undertaken in accordance with Kent County Council's "Plan Bee" initiative, of which all contractors and workers are to familiarise themselves with

## Ditch around London-bound bus shelter near Courtenay Road

Keep ditch clear of vegetation and maintain drainage function All works to be undertaken in accordance with Kent County Council's "Plan Bee" initiative

### **Equipment**

All equipment to be provided by the contractor. Equipment used should be suitable for purpose and properly maintained.

## Insurance

The contractor is responsible for ensuring adequate public liability insurance cover is in place at all times. A copy of the certificate to be provided to the Council on agreement of the contract and before commencement of any works.

### Health & Safety

The contractor is responsible for ensuring all Health & Safety regulations are adhered to including any signage required whilst working.

### Contract Term

This is a fixed term contract for a period of 36 months commencing June 2022, subject to review after 12 months to ensure all works are of a satisfactory standard.
