Butlers Hill, Dargate

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2024

Openreach works.

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Butlers Hill, Dargate.

A closure is planned from 2nd April 2024, for up to one day, between the hours of 10.30 and 16.30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008WF9J636J-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Butlers Hill will be closed between the junction with Crockham Road and the junction with Dargate Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Dargate Road, Courtenay Road, A2 Canterbury Road, The Street, Staplestreet Road, Church Hill and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
