Upper Harbledown Slip Road, Upper Harbledown

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2023

To allow bridge repair works and other associated works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Upper Harbledown Slip Road, Upper Harbledown.

A closure is planned from 6th February 2023, with estimated completion by 31st March 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (FN40443139324-01 - National Highways). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Upper Harbledown Slip Road will be closed in a northerly direction only from the junction with Poldhurst Farm Road to the junction with London Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route any through traffic is Upper Harbledown slip Road, A2 Dover Road, Dunkirk westbound offslip, Canterbury Road, A2 Dover Road, Harbledown East bound off slip and London Road.

There will also be further closures of the road in both directions which are planned to take place at night times only on the following dates - 6 February for 3 nights and 27 March for 3 nights (20.00hrs to 06.00hrs), to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative routes for through traffic traveling northbound is via Upper Harbledown slip Road, A2 Dover Road, Dunkirk westbound offslip, Canterbury Road, A2 Dover Road, Harbledown East bound off slip and London Road.

The alternative route for through traffic travelling southbound is via London Road, Wingate Hill, A2050 Harbledown bypass, London Road roundabout, Harbledown bypass, Harbledown westbound on slip, A2 Dover Road.

Access through the closure will be maintained for residents in Poldhurst Farm Road using long delay boards.

The closures are required in conjunction with road closures and lane closures on the A2 Dover Road (night times only) and with temporary traffic signals on Poldhurst Farm Road.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while bridge repair works are undertaken by National Highways.
