KCC Parish seminar on 28.12.19 JT and JC to attend and meet Simon Jones re TRO's. KALC AGM meeting on 30.12.19 JT to attend.

Need to make progress on making website compliant.

JT attended a meeting about lorry parking at Gate services – SBC and police seem unable to do anything. Most of the problem has been solved (at gate Services) by the bollards but no enforcement re other sites.

Ashford has put up enforcement signs at Westwell which worked well, but only for one year so not a solution. DfT will not enable long term, so this has stopped. Needs to be County and Country wide initiative.
