TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2024**

Openreach works.

To allow replacement pole works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Butlers Hill, Dargate.

A closure is planned from 10th May 2024, with estimated completion by 13th May 2024, between the hours of 09.00 and 17.00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WF9KCT6J-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Butlers Hill will be closed from the junction of Crockham Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while replacement pole works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Butlers Hill, Dargate Road, Courtenay Road, Canterbury Road, Staplestreet Road, Church Hill, Butlers Hill and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
