**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & 30 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2023

To allow Section 278 works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A2 London Road, Boughton Under Blean.

Restrictions are planned from 5th June 2023, with estimated completion by 19th June 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE27836110960-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The works will be carried out in phases, as detailed below:-

5th to 16th June

A2 London Road, Boughton Under Blean

30mph speed limit to be imposed between Brenley Corner for 300m West. The restriction will be in place 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

16th to 19th June

A2 London Road, Boughton Under Blean

Road will be closed westbound only at the junction with Brenley Corner, from 22:00 on 16th June, the road will be reopened at 05:00 on 19th June.

The alternative route for motorway traffic is via Brenley Corner, M2 J7 on slip, M2, M2 J6 off slip, A251 Ashford Road, A2 Canterbury Road, London Road.

The alternative route for non-motorway traffic is via Brenley Corner, A299 Thanet Way, Thanet Way Slip, Whitstable Road, Graveney Road, B2040 Love Lane.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while Section 278 works are undertaken by Henderson-Taylor (Public Works) Ltd.
