A299 THANET WAY (SLIP-OFF TO STAPLE STREET), GRAVENEY

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that A299 Thanet Way (Slip-off to Staple Street), Graveney will be closed to through traffic, on or after 14th December 2020 for up to 1 day.

The road will be closed at the A299 Thanet Way to eastbound traffic only.

The alternative route is via A299 Thanet Way, Brenley Corner slip-off, A2 Brenley Corner roundabout, A299 Thanet Way slip-on, Whitstable Road, Staple Street Road and Staple Street.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:30 hrs and 15:30 hrs.

This closure is necessary to enable tree maintenance works to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
