**Openreach works.**

**To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Butlers Hill, Dargate.**

**A closure is planned from 2nd April 2024, for up to one day, between the hours of 10.30 and 16.30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008WF9J636J-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)**

**Butlers Hill will be closed between the junction with Crockham Road and the junction with Dargate Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.**

**The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.**

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Dargate Road, Courtenay Road, A2 Canterbury Road, The Street, Staplestreet Road, Church Hill and vice versa.**

**Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
