THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2021

To allow rail renewal works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Clockhouse Lane, Boughton Under Blean.

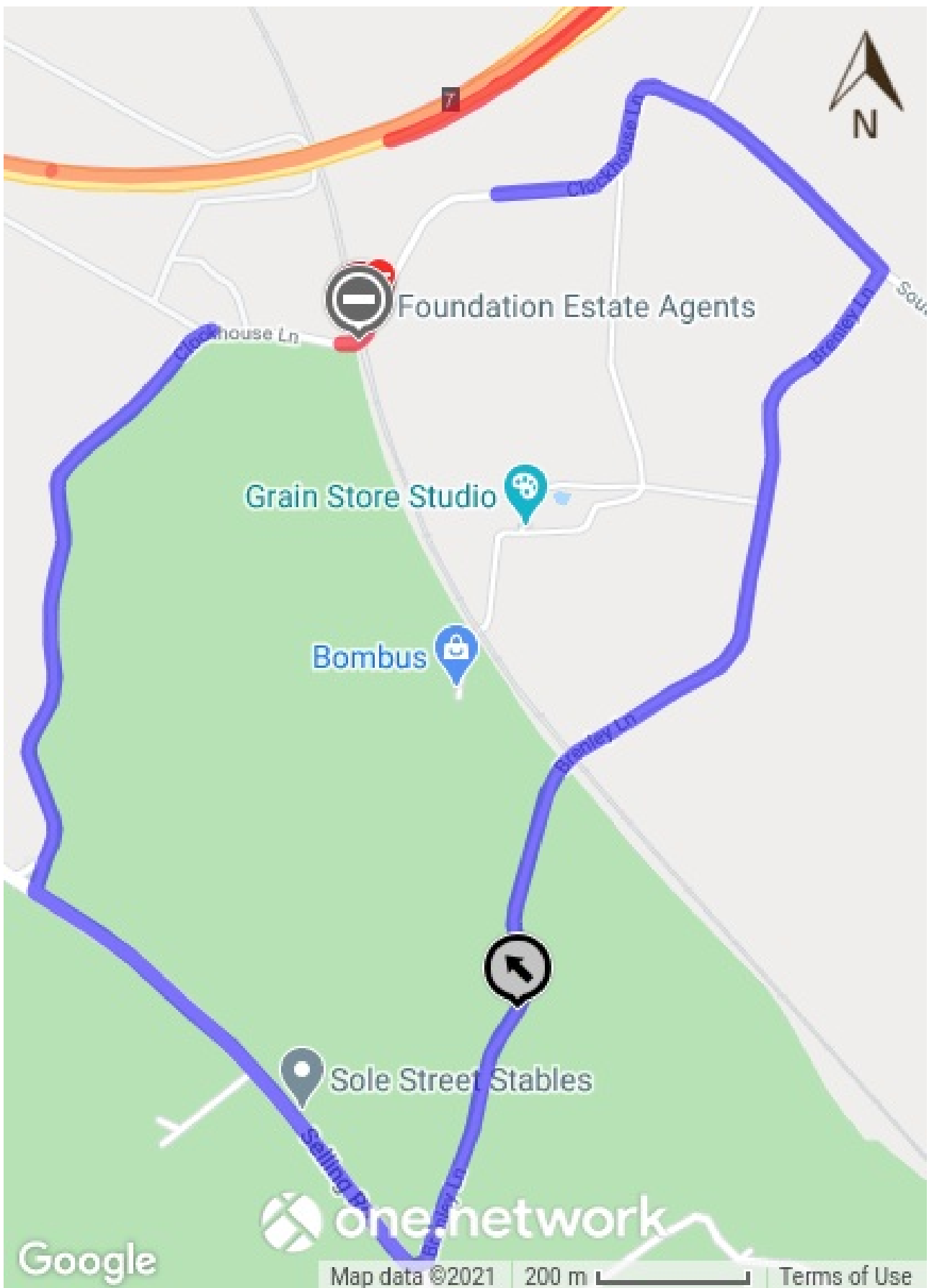
A closure is planned from 6th February 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 07:00 and 19:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL870FDM-53-51-060221 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Clockhouse Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while rail renewal works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Clockhouse Lane, Brenley Lane, Selling Road and vice versa.
