TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Courtenay Road, Dunkirk will be closed to through traffic, on or after 27th August 2024 for up to 4 days.

The road will be closed between the junctions of Dawes Road and Dargate Road.

The alternative route is via Dargate Road, Butlers Hill, Church Hill, Staplestreet Road, Dawes Road and vice versa.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
