TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Courtenay Road, Dunkirk will be closed to through traffic, on or after 6th October 2024 for up to 4 days.

The road will be closed between the junctions of Dawes Road and Dargate Road.

The alternative route is via: Courtenay Road, Dargate Road, Plumpudding Lane, Highstreet Road, Monks Hill Road, Seasalter Road, Head Hill Road, Head Hill, Whitstable Road, Staplestreet Road, Staple Street, Staplestreet Road, The Street, Canterbury Road, Courtenay Road and vice versa.

This closure is necessary to enable water pipe repairs to be carried out by South East Water.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
