(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER DECEMBER 2023

Openreach works.

To allow installation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Crockham Lane, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 22nd December 2023, for up to one day, between the hours of 08.30 and 16.30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC005WF2F5L7XAA-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Crockham Lane will be closed between Church Hill and Crockham Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while installation works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Crockham Road, Butlers Hill, Church Hill and vice versa. Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
