TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Dawes Road, Dunkirk will be closed to through traffic, on or after 27th September 2022 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed outside Pottery Cottage.

The alternative route is via Staplestreet Road, Canterbury Road, Courtenay Road, Dawes Road and vice versa.

This closure is necessary to enable overhead cable repairs to be carried out by UK Power Networks.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
