Denstroude Lane, Dunkirk

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2021

To allow ducting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Denstroude Lane, Dunkirk.

A closure is planned from 4th March 2021, with estimated completion by 8th March 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC118CANTERBURYHV2240 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network


Denstroude Lane will be closed from outside Bradbourne Cottage to outside Denstroude Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while ducting works are undertaken by BT Openreach.

The alternative route for traffic travelling eastbound is via Dargate Road, Plumpudding Lane, Unnamed Road From Highstreet Road To Plumpudding Lane, Highstreet Road, A299 Thanet Way, Thanet Way Slip Way, A2990 Thanet Way, A20 Clapham Hill, Pean Hill, Honey Hill and Denstroude Lane.

The alternative route for traffic travelling westbound is Denstroude Lane, Honey Hill, Pean Hill, A20 Clapham Hill, Westbound Slip onto A299 from Wraik Hill Roundabout, A299 Thanet Way, Dargate Road, High Street Road, Plumpudding Lane, Dargate Road and Denstroude Lane.
