## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2021**

To allow works to be carried out to install a new BT pole, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Fostall, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 15th March 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SE000000106067ONSA - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network


Fostall will be closed 85 metres northeast of Plum Tree Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while works to install a new pole are undertaken by BT Openreach.

The alternative route for traffic travelling westbound is via Fostall, A299 Thanet Way, Thanet Way Slip, Staple Street, Church Hill and Forstall.

The alternative route for traffic travelling eastbound is via Forstall, Butlers Hill, Plumpudding Lane, Highstreet Road, A299 Thanet Way and Forstall.
