(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow ducting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Fox Lane, Boughton Under Blean.


A closure is planned from 19th March 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SE0000000128100ONSA - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Fox Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of Foxhill Stud, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while ducting works are undertaken by BT Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Fox Lane, Selling Road, Crouch Lane, Kit Hill, South Street and vice versa.
