Horselees Road, Boughton Under Blean

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Horselees Road, Boughton Under Blean.

A closure is planned from 17th November 2021, with estimated completion by 1st December 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50073755780-03 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Horselees Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 21, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while electrical connection works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Horselees Road, Colonels Lane, The Street and vice versa.
