(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2021

To allow water main connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Horselees Road, Boughton Under Blean.


A closure is planned from 26th April 2021, with estimated completion by 30th April 2021. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Horselees Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 28, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while water main connection works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Horselees Road, Burnt Oast Road, St Pauls Road, Highview Close and vice versa.
