TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Kemsdale Road, Faversham will be closed to through traffic, on or after 6th January 2021 for up to 2 Months.

The entire length of Kemsdale Road will be closed.

The alternative route is via Kayes Lane, Church Hill, Staple Street Road, Kayes Lane and Staple Street Road towards Church Hill and Kayes Lane.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway maintenance to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
