(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2021

To allow overhead structure works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Kit Hill, Selling.


A closure is planned from 19th January 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008OGEA49720449 - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Kit Hill will be closed from outside number 1 to the junction with Crouch Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while overhead structure works are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Kit Hill, Selling Road, Brenley Lane, South Street and vice versa.
