Park Road, Faversham
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER DECEMBER 2020

To allow capacity increase works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Park Road, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 14th December 2020, with estimated completion by 23rd December 2020, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW046W117359663-00949_01 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the work will be displayed on [one.network](#)

Park Road will be closed outside numbers 43 & 45, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

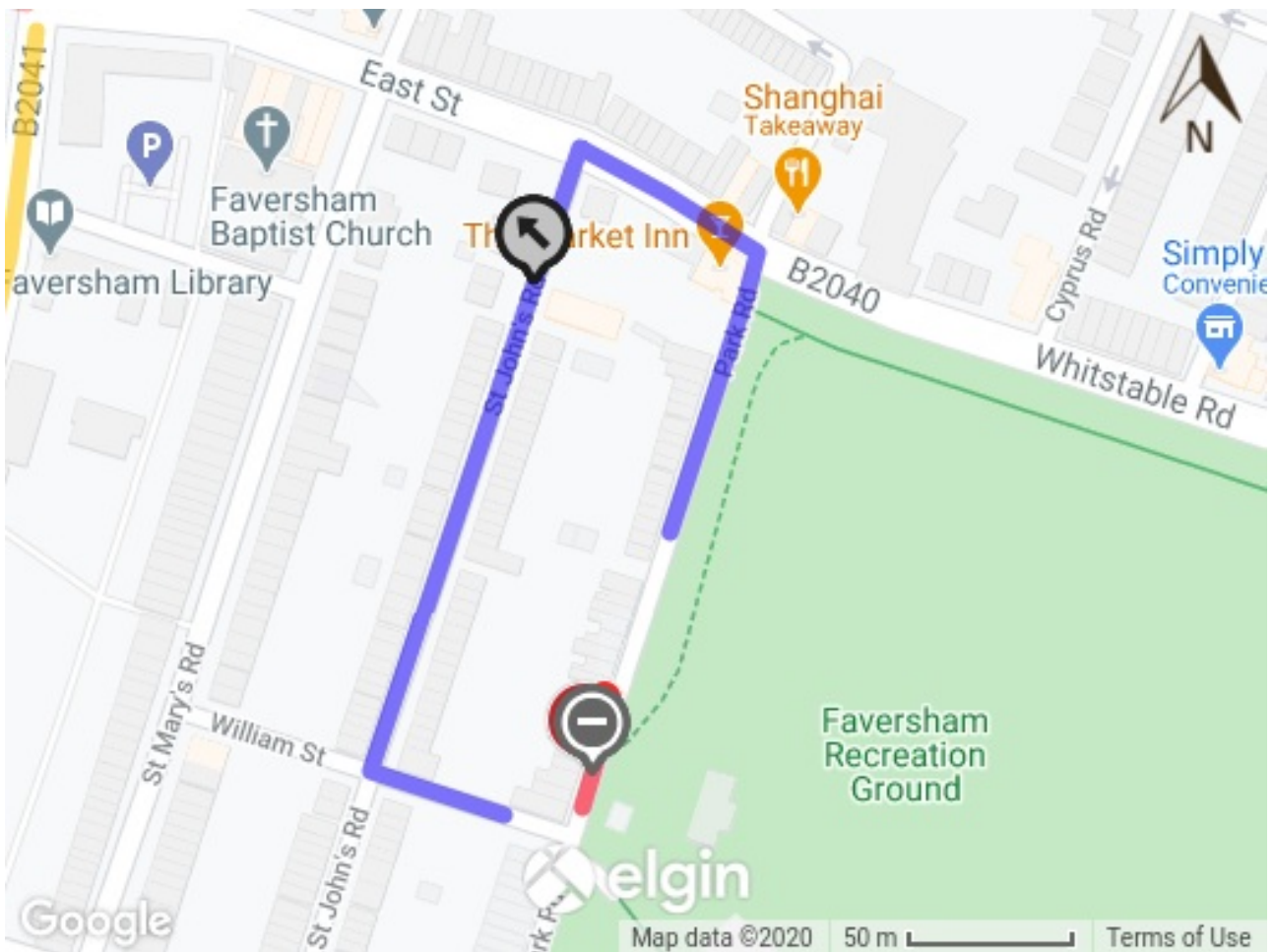
The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while capacity increase works are undertaken by SGN.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Park Road, East Street, St Johns Road, William Street and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to reopen the road outside of working hours.
