(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow water main connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Horselees Road, Boughton Under Blean.


A closure is planned from 8th November 2021, with estimated completion by 12th November 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB006-28632275-02 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Horselees Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 23, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while water main connection works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Horselees Road, Colonels Lane, The Street and vice versa.
