Kays Lane, Hernhill

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow underground structure works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Kays Lane, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 15th November 2021 at 09:30, with estimated completion by 15th November 2021 at 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008WC4TK72D01-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Kays Lane will be closed between the junctions with Church Hill and Kemsdale Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while underground structure works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Church Hill, Staple Street, Kemsdale Road and vice versa.
