South Street & Scoggers Hill, Boughton Under Blean

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to lay new ducting, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of South Street & Scoggers Hill, Boughton Under Blean.

A closure is planned from 22nd November 2021, with estimated completion by 26th November 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SECHA0000167997ONSA-02 & BC417SECHA00167997ONSA-1 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on One.Network

South Street will be closed in the vicinity of the Scoggers Hill junction. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Scoggers Hill will be closed in the vicinity of Poplars at the South Street junction. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new ducting works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic on South Street is via South Street, Hickmans Green, Colonels Lane, The Street, Stockers Hill, Canterbury Road, Nine Ash Lane and vice versa.

The alternative route for any through traffic on Scoggers Hill is via South Street, Jezzards Lane, Rhode Common and vice versa.
