(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow works to be carried out under a section 278 agreement, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Staple Street, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 12th April 2022, with estimated completion by 20th April 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE10040301309-02 - BEC Construction Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Staple Street will be closed at the new entrance of Forge Farm Row, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Section 278 works are undertaken by BEC Construction Ltd .

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Staplestreet Road, The Street, Bull Lane, Butts Hill and vice versa.
