(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow ducting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Staple Street, Hernhill.


A closure is planned from 8th November 2021, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, with estimated completion by 10th November 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SE000000157365ONSA1-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Staple Street will be closed from outside Forge Orchard to outside number 5, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while ducting works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Church Hill, Kays Lane, Kemsdale Road, Staple Street and vice versa.
