Preston Street, Faversham
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to install a new gas service, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Preston Street, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 4th January 2021, with estimated completion by 8th January 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW046W117448304-00996_01 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site displayed on [one.network](#)

Preston Street will be closed in the general vicinity of number 23, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

It will also be necessary to place the following restrictions on Preston Street and East Street, Faversham, as detailed below.

- The one-way Order on Preston Street, Faversham will be temporarily suspended from the junction with East Street to the junction with Stone Street.
- The one-way Order on East Street, Faversham will be temporarily reversed from the junction with B2040 Crescent Road to the junction with Preston Street.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while works to install a new gas service are undertaken by SGN.

There is no alternative route for this closure.

The closure will be in conjunction with the gate closures on Preston Street, between the hours of 10:00 and 16:00, with residential access maintained around these time constraints.
