## **TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Kent County Council gives notice that for the safety of the public and workforce during roadworks, a temporary mandatory speed limit of 30 MPH will be imposed on a section of Dawes Road, Dunkirk.

The 30 MPH applies in both directions on Dawes Road, Dunkirk between the junctions of Staple Street Road and Courtenay Road, to the extent indicated by signage clearly displayed on site.

This takes effect on 6th March 2023 for up to 21 days. The restrictions will be lifted as soon as works are completed and it is safe to do so.

The restrictions have been introduced for the safety of traffic movements whilst works take place on Canterbury Road by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
