## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2021**

To allow works to be carried out on South East Water's apparatus, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Staple Street, Hernhill.


A closure is planned from 12th April 2021, with estimated completion by 14th April 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00623494934 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <a href="One.Network">One.Network</a>

Staple Street will be closed west of the junction with Kemsdale Lodge, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while works on apparatus are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Staple Street, Butts Hill, Bull Lane, Stockers Hill, Canterbury Road, A2 Boughton Bypass, Brenley Corner, A299 Thanet Way, Thanet Way Slip, Whitstable Road, Staple Street Road and vice versa.
