## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2023**

South East Water works.

To allow new connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Staplestreet Road, Dunkirk.

A closure is planned from 15th November 2023, with estimated completion by 17th November 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00946787729-01 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Staplestreet Road will be closed in the vicinity of Thatch Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new connection works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Staple Street, A299 Thanet Way, A2 Brenley Corner, A2 Canterbury Road, Stockers Hill, The Street and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
