## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A

## **TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022**

To allow the annual wheelie bin event to take place, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Staplestreet Road, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 23rd July 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 12:00 and 15:00. The scheduled dates may vary for this event with appropriate signage displayed on site and the event will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Staplestreet Road will be closed from the junction with Church Hill to outside the junction to Mount Ephraim Gardens, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and event personnel while the annual wheelie bin event is held by The Three Horseshoes.

The alternative route is via Staplestreet Road, A229 Thanet Way Slip, Thanet Way, Brenley Corner, A2 Boughton Bypass, Canterbury Road, Stockers Hill, The Street, Staplestreet Road and vice versa.
