**Saxon Road, Faversham**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2021**

**To allow water main connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Saxon Road, Faversham.**

**A closure is planned from 12th April 2021, with estimated completion by 23rd April 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB006-26957925 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)**

**Saxon Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 44, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.**

**The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while water main connection works are undertaken by South East Water.**

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Saxon Road, Stone Street, Roman Road, Norman Road and vice versa.**
