(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2021

To allow water main connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Saxon Road, Faversham.

Saxon Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 44, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while water main connection works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Saxon Road, Stone Street, Roman Road, Norman Road and vice versa.
