Waterham Road, Hernhill
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2021

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Waterham Road, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 18th May 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SE000000087375ONSA - BT Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

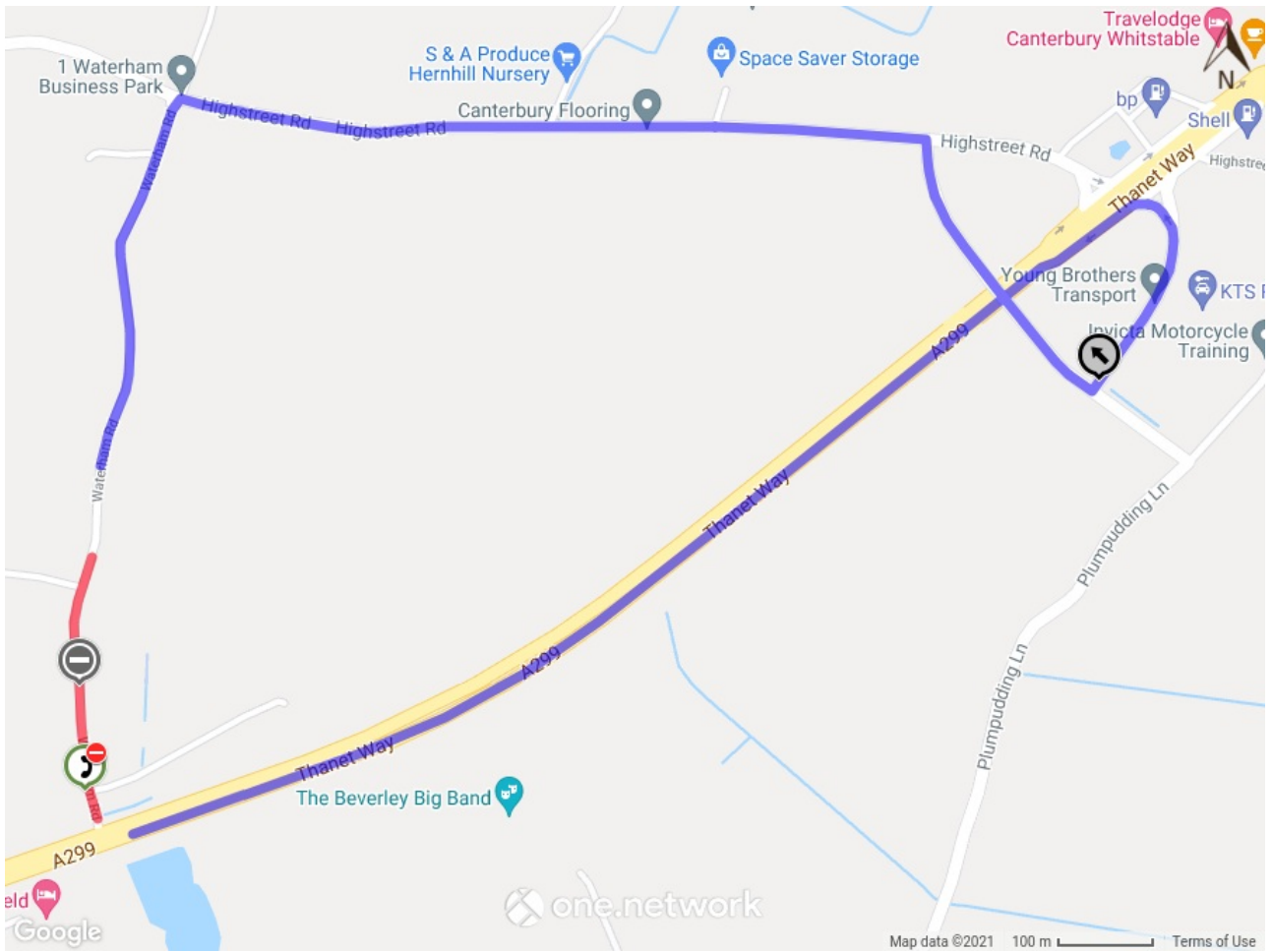
Waterham Road will be closed from the junction with A299 Thanet Way to outside Mallards Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by BT Openreach.

The alternative route for traffic travelling southbound is via Highstreet Road, Unnamed Road From Highstreet Road To Plumpudding Lane and A299 Thanet Way.

The alternative route for traffic travelling northbound is via A299 Thanet Way, High Street Road and Waterham Road.
