B2040 Quay Lane & Conduit Street, Faversham

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2021

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Quay Lane & Conduit Street, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 25th June 2021, between the hours of 20:00 and 05:00 (excluding weekends), with estimated completion by 29th June 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70537945731 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>


B2040 Quay Lane & Conduit Street will be closed between the junctions with Church Street and Bridge Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while carriageway resurfacing works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic travelling on the B2040 is via B2040 North Lane, South Road, Ospringe Road, A2 London Road, The Mall, B2040 Forbes Road, Station Road, Newton Road, Crescent Road, Court Street and vice versa.

The alternative route for traffic travelling on Bridge Road is via Bridge Road, Church Street, Bramblehill Road, Reedland Crescent, Sevenacre Road, Barnfield Road, Priory Road, Daving Hill, Curtis Way and West Street.
