CROUCH LANE, SELLING

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Crouch Lane, Selling will be closed to through traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists on or after 2nd August 2021 for up to 21 days.

The road will be closed 10 metres, either side of the railway bridge.

The alternative route is via Crouch Lane, South Street, Fox Lane and Selling Road.

In addition, it is also necessary to close the public right of way (ref 0220/ZR631/2), 10 metres either side of the footway bridge.

A signed alternative route is in place.

This closure is necessary to enable bridge repairs to be carried out by Network Rail.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
