## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2021**

To allow tree surgery works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Owens Court Lane, Selling.


A closure is planned from 28th June 2021, with estimated completion by 2nd July 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC111WC4TV15V001 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <a href="One.Network">One.Network</a>

Owens Court Lane will be closed between the junctions with Selling Road and Winding Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while tree surgery works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Selling Road, Brenley Lane, Featherbed Lane, Winding Hill and vice versa.
