SELLING ROAD, FAVERSHAM

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Selling Road, Faversham will be closed to through traffic, on or after 27th January 2022 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed between the junction of Selling Road and the rail bridge.

The alternative route is via Selling Road, Crouch Lane, South Street and Fox Lane.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 08:00 hrs and 17:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable drainage works to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
