Selling Road, Selling

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2022

To allow maintenance works to be carried out on apparatus, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Selling Road, Selling.

A closure is planned from 15th March 2022, with estimated completion by 18th March 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00628547293-01 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Selling Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Little Oast, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while maintenance works on apparatus are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Selling Road, The Street, Selling Street, Hogbens Hill, Winding Hill, Newhouse Lane, A251 Ashford Road, Faversham Road, A252 Canterbury Road, Maidstone Road, Mulberry Hill, Cobbs Hill and vice versa.
