South Street, Boughton Under Blean

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2022

To allow reconstruction works to be carried out on a collapsed wall, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of South Street, Boughton Under Blean.

A closure is planned from 31st January 2022, with estimated completion by 10th February 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE05030060557-01 - Brighter Homes Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

South Street will be closed in the general vicinity of Boughton Church House, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while reconstruction works on a collapsed wall are undertaken by Brighter Homes Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via South Street, Nine Ash Lane, Canterbury Road, Stockers Hill, The Street, Horselees Road, Colonels Lane, Hickmans Green and vice versa.
