Staple Street, Hernhill

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2021

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Staple Street, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 16th June 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SE000000089416ONSA - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Staple Street will be closed between the junctions with Bull Lane and Chalkey Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Staple Street, Staple Street Road, Whitstable Road, A299 Thanet Way Slip, Thanet Way, Kemsdale Road and vice versa.
