(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2021

To allow remedial reinstatement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of West Street, Faversham.


A closure is planned from 20th June 2021 at 06:00, with estimated completion by 20th June 2021 at 08:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB006-17034147 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

West Street will be closed in the general vicinity of number 25 and 45, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while remedial reinstatement works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Caslocke Street, Hatch Street, Beckett Street, Napleton Road, Tanners Street and South Road.
