## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2021**

To allow pole testing and tree cutting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Butlers Hill, Dargate.


A closure is planned from 7th July 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008PTMS131144 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <a href="Openreach">Openreach</a>).

Butlers Hill will be closed between the junctions with Woodlands and Crockham Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole testing and tree cutting works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Butlers Hill, Dargate Road, Courtenay Road, Canterbury Road, The Street, Staplestreet Road, Church Hill and vice versa.
