## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2021**

To allow frame and cover maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Curtis Way, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 3rd May 2021, with estimated completion by 5th May 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00626822515 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>


Curtis Way will be closed in the general vicinity of number 3, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while frame and cover maintenance works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for traffic travelling westbound is via Bysing Wood Road, Western Link, A2 London Road, B2040 Ospringe Street, Ospringe Road, South Road, Napleton Road, Tanners Street and Curtis Way.

The alternative route for traffic travelling eastbound is via Curtis Way, West Street, B2040 South Road, Ospringe Road, Ospringe Street, A2 London Road, Western Link and Bysing Wood Road.
