(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2021

To allow rail maintenance & other associated works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Monkshill Road, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 16th May 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL870VIR-54-77-160521 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on One-Network

Monkshill Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while rail maintenance & other associated works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Monkshill Road, Seasalter Road, Head Hill Road, Head Hill, Whitstable Road, Thanet Way Slip, A299 Thanet Way, Highstreet Road and vice versa.
