**Staple Street, Hernhill**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2022**

To allow gas main service works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Staple Street, Hernhill.

A closure is planned from 24th January 2022, with estimated completion by 1st February 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW071W118257401-01194\_01-02 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Staple Street will be closed in the general vicinity of Forge Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while gas main service works are undertaken by SGN.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bull Lane, The Street, Staplestreet Road and vice versa.
