## **TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2023**

**UK Power Networks works.** 

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Street (Service Road), Boughton under Blean.

A closure is planned from 16th October 2023, for up to one day, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50016961382-03 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

The Street (Service Road), Boughton under Blean will be closed in the vicinity of number 118, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

There is no alternative route for this closure, however, access will be maintained at all times when it is safe to do so. Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
