(PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS & CYCLISTS)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2021

To allow renewal works to be carried out on a joint box, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit pedestrians & cyclists on Ticklebelly Alley, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 1st February 2021, with estimated completion by 3rd February 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SE000000113047ONSA - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Ticklebelly Alley will be closed between the junctions with Aldred Road and The Mall, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while joint box renewal works are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Aldred Road, Forbes Road, The Mall and vice versa.
