## Various Roads, Boughton Under Blean

## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2022**

To allow gas main replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads in Boughton Under Blean.

Closures are planned from 7th February 2022, with estimated completion by 30th May 2022. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

The works will be carried out in phases, as detailed below.

**Colonels Lane, Boughton Under Blean** 

Colonels Lane will be closed from 7th February 2022, with estimated completion by 25th February 2022.

The road will be closed from outside number 75 to outside number 87, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Horselees Road, The Street, Stockers Hill, Canterbury Road, Nine Ash Lane, South Street, Crouch Lane, Selling Road, Fox Lane and South Street.

Hickmans Green, Boughton Under Blean

Hickmans Green will be closed from 7th February 2022, with estimated completion by 25th March 2022.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Colonels Lane and Snakes Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Colonels Lane, Horselees Road, The Street, Stockers Hill, Canterbury Road Nine Ash Lane, South Street, Crouch Lane, Selling Road, Fox Lane and South Street.

Brickfield Lane, Boughton Under Blean

Brickfield Lane will be closed from 14th February 2022, with estimated completion by 25th March 2022.

The road will be closed at the junction with Hickmans Green, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Colonels Lane, Horselees Road, The Street, Stockers Hill, Canterbury Road Nine Ash Lane, South Street, Crouch Lane, Selling Road, Fox Lane and South Street.

South Street, Boughton Under Blean

South Street will be closed from 21st February 2022, with estimated completion by 30th May 2022.

The road will be closed at the junction with Snake Lane to outside Nailbourne Oast, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via South Street, Hickmans Green, Brickfield Lane, Canterbury Road, Nine Ash Lane, South Street, Crouch Lane, Selling Road and Fox Lane.

North Lane, Boughton Under Blean

North Lane will be closed from 7th March 2022, with estimated completion by 1st April 2022.

The road will be closed at the junction with South Street to outside Honeysuckle Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

There is no alternative route for this closure. However, residential access will be maintained at all times, when it is safe to do so.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while gas main replacement works are undertaken by SGN.
