**Various Town Roads, Faversham**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2020**

**For the safety of the public to help achieve social-distancing for economic recovery following the coronavirus pandemic, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various town roads in Faversham.**

**All vehicular traffic shall be prohibited on the following roads, as detailed below.**

**Court Street, Faversham - From the junction with Market Place to the junction with Crescent Road.**

**Market Place, Faversham - For its entire length.**

**Middle Row, Faversham - For its entire length.**

**West Street, Faversham - From the junction with Market Place to a point in line with the boundary of 121 and 122 West Street.**

**East Street - From the junction with Newton Road to the junction with Preston Street.**

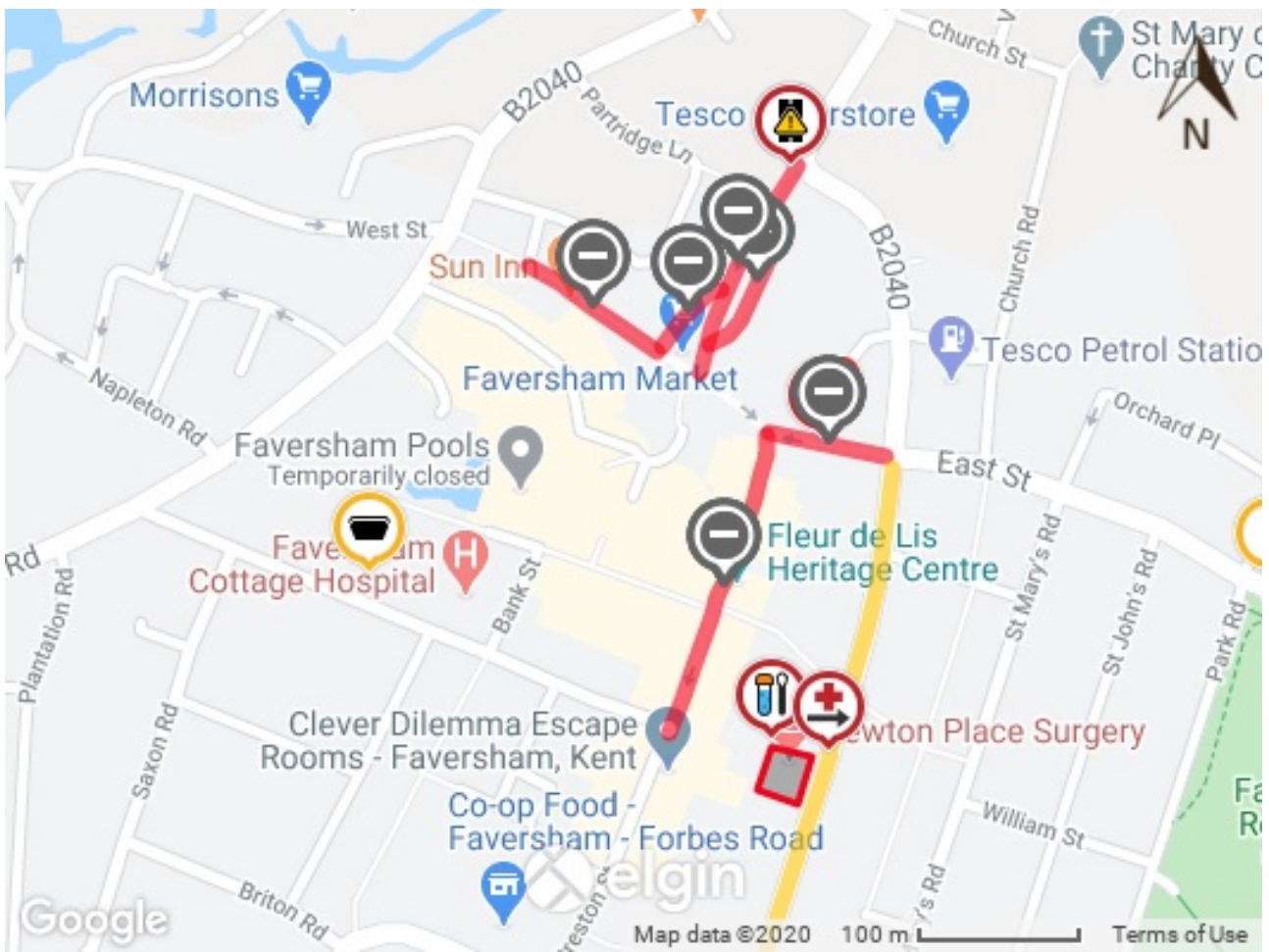
**Preston Street - From the junction with East Street to the junction with Stone Street.**

**The above restrictions apply from Monday to Saturday inclusive each week between 10:00 hours and 16:00 hours each day, thereby extending the current hours of pedestrianisation.**

**This Order comes into force from 06 July 2020 and remains in force for up to six months.**

**Whilst in force, this Order over-rides the existing Traffic Regulations that prohibit traffic on the above roads.**

**These restrictions have been requested by and in conjunction with Faversham Town Council, and any enquires concerning this should be addressed directly to them.**
